

MRS. SARAH A. SWEANEY DEAD

Funeral Services in First Christian Church at 3 Tomorrow

Mrs. Sarah A. Sweaney, 83 years old, died at her home, 105 South Lincoln avenue, at 5:55 yesterday afternoon. The funeral services will be held in the First Christian church at 3 tomorrow afternoon. They will be conducted by the pastor, the Rev. E. A. Blackman. Interment will be in Elmwood beside the body of her husband, Frederick R. Sweaney, who died thirty-three years ago.

Mrs. Sweaney had lived here forty-five years. She was born in Allegheny, Pa., January 6, 1840. She was married in Ohio and went by canal boat to New Philadelphia, where she and Mr. Sweaney made their home before coming here.

Death was caused by old age, the final illness not beginning until last Monday.

Mrs. Sweaney is survived by six children, four sons and two daughters. The sons are Edward of Brewster, Wash.; William of Morris, Okla.; and Sheridan and Clinton of this city. The daughters, Mrs. Victor Phillips and Mrs. George Myers, also live here. All the children were with their mother, except the oldest son, in Washington.
